Accessible Service:

- Monday through Saturday
- Shuttles run Monday through Saturday except on holidays noted in Holiday Schedule.
- If your stop is between two designated time points, you can flag the vehicle at designated bus stop. *Note: Bus will stop only at legal bus stops on Livingston Avenue. For designated bus stops, obtain list from driver.*
- Bus times are approximate and the bus will usually be running 1-2 minutes behind schedule.
- MCAT also offers curb to curb services for senior citizens and people with disabilities. Reservations can be made by calling: 1-800-221-3520.

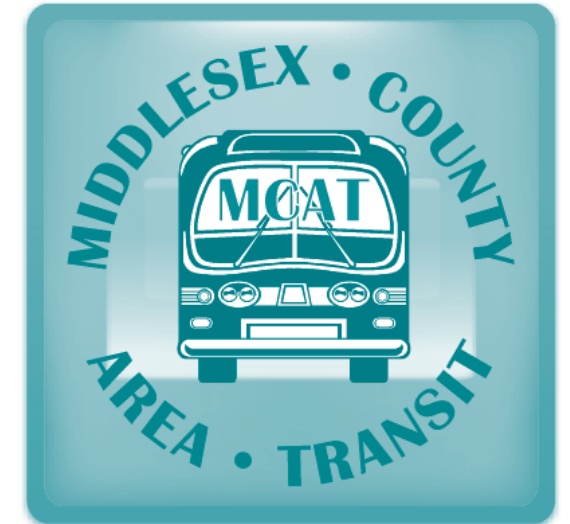
